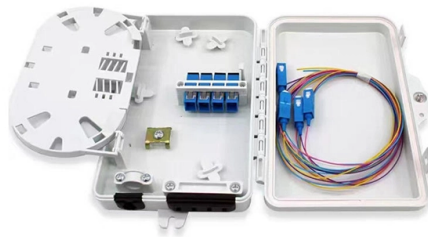


How to handle a network cabinet with power on

Always prioritize safety, proper power distribution, and organized cabling when working on a live network cabinet. **Safety First** When handling a network cabinet with power on, ensure you minimize the risk of electrical shock or equipment damage. Label both ends of every cable for easy identification during troubleshooting or maintenance. Avoid sharp bends or strain on cables, which can damage connectors or reduce airflow.

Airflow and Equipment Access Maintaining airflow is essential to prevent overheating: Arrange equipment to allow unobstructed airflow from front to rear of the cabinet. Avoid blocking vents with cables or tools while working on live equipment. Keep heavier or heat-generating devices lower in the cabinet to improve cooling efficiency.
