

How to hang cables in cable trays

Step 4: Lay and Organize Cables Arrange cables neatly in the tray, avoiding excessive bending or crossing. Maintain proper spacing and do not exceed 40-50% of tray capacity to prevent overheating. Use cable ties, clamps, or straps at regular intervals to secure cables to the tray rungs or bottom. Label cables for easy identification and maintenance.

Step 5: Final Checks Ensure all cables are supported and not hanging loosely. Verify grounding and bonding requirements are met. Inspect for sharp edges, proper spacing, and compliance with electrical codes.
