

How to identify a router from a fiber optic box

Check the IP Address: Most routers can be accessed via a web browser using the default IP address, usually 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1.

Login Credentials: Enter the username and password provided by your ISP to access settings. Some ISPs require additional configuration like VLAN tagging or PPPoE.

Indicator Lights: Routers and ONTs have status lights. A steady light usually indicates an active connection, while blinking or red lights may indicate issues.

Place the router in a central location for optimal Wi-Fi coverage. Use CAT6 or higher Ethernet cables to connect the ONT to the router for stable, high-speed data transfer. If unsure, consult your ISP or check the device labels; the ONT typically handles signal conversion, while the ro...
