

How to identify drop fiber optic cables

Fiber optic drop cables are the final link in FTTH networks, identifiable by their fiber count, reinforcement type, sheath material, and structural design for indoor or outdoor deployment.

- Indoor vs. Outdoor:** Indoor cables often have LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) jackets, while outdoor cables include UV-resistant, water-blocking, and flame-retardant jackets for environmental protection.
- Reinforcement and Strength Members:** Metallic or FRP rods provide tensile strength and lightning protection. Self-supporting designs may include steel wires for aerial deployment, allowing the cable to span poles without additional support.
- Sheath Material:** LSZH or flame-retardant PVC for indoor safety. PE or anti-UV jackets for outdoor durability, often with rodent-resistant or crush-resistant layers.
- Deployment Considerations:**
 - Aerial Drop Cables:** Suspended between poles, often flat figure-8 or self-supporting round cables.
 - Underground/Direct-Burial Cables:** Round cables with water-blocking and crush-resistant jackets.
 - Indoor Wiring:** Compact, flexible cables suitable for ducts or open wiring inside buildings.
- Termination Methods:**
 - Fusion Splicing:** Preferred for permanent, high-performance connections.
 - Mechanical Splicing or Connectors:** Used where flexibility or field termination is required.
