

How to install an optical cable protection box

Fiber Handling and Splicing Strip the cable jacket and buffer coating carefully without damaging the fibers. Clean the fibers and connectors using alcohol or a specialized cleaner to remove dust and oils. Arrange fibers in the splice tray according to color codes and perform splicing (fusion or mechanical) following manufacturer guidelines. Install adapters and connectors in the designated slots, ensuring proper alignment to maintain signal integrity.
