

How to install junction box components

Step 3: Run and Prepare Cables Feed cables through the clamps or glands. Strip the outer sheathing about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch beyond the clamp, then strip individual conductors $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (19 mm) for connection. Ensure cables are secured and clamps are tightened to prevent movement.

Step 4: Make Wire Connections Group same-colored wires together. Twist exposed ends and secure with wire nuts or terminal blocks. For multiple connections, use DIN rails or junction strips inside the box for organized wiring. Verify all connections are tight and insulated to prevent shorts or sparks.

Step 5: Seal and Finish Push all wires neatly into the box. Place the cover or lid, ensuring it is accessible for future inspection. For outdoor boxes, ensure gaskets and cable glands are properly sealed to prevent moisture ingress.
