

How to install pigtails

Secure the Connection Cover the twisted wires with a wire nut or insert into a butt connector. For soldered connections, apply solder and cover with heat shrink tubing for insulation ().

Grounding In metal electrical boxes, attach the grounding conductor to a green screw or use a ground clip. In plastic boxes, route the grounding wire directly to the device terminal ().

Test the Connection Gently tug on the wires to ensure they are secure. Restore power and verify circuit functionality with a voltage tester or multimeter ().

Best Practices Match wire gauge to the circuit's amperage rating (e.g., 14 AWG for 15A, 12 AWG for 20A) (). Use UL-listed connectors to comply with safety codes and reduce fire risk (). Avoid overloading terminals; pigtails preve...
