

How to keep cable trays straight

Alignment and Leveling Check each section with a spirit level or laser level to ensure trays are straight and horizontal. Make small adjustments before fully tightening connectors. Avoid forcing trays into position, as this can cause misalignment or stress on joints .

Final Checks After installation, inspect the entire run for loose connections, sagging, or misaligned sections. Ensure all trays are properly supported, grounded, and bonded according to standards . Label and document the installation for future maintenance. By following these steps—careful planning, proper support spacing, precise use of connectors, and continuous alignment checks—you can achieve a straight, safe, and durable cable tray installation.
