

How to lay cables on cable tray supports

Use appropriate fasteners: metal anchors for concrete, steel-grade clamps for steel structures. Verify that the tray is level and straight before tightening.
- Assemble and Install the Tray** Connect tray sections using splice plates to bridge joints. Align trays carefully to avoid sagging or misalignment. For long runs, consider using cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable laying. Handle materials carefully to prevent coating damage, especially for GI trays.
- Lay the Cables** Place cables in the tray according to type and separation requirements. Maintain vertical and horizontal spacing to avoid interference between electrical and telecommunication cables (e.g., 30 cm vertical separation for multi-layer trays), .Us...
