Maintenance should include: Wire reinforcement or replacement of damaged or broken cables. Adjustment of sag and tension to maintain proper clearance from the ground and adjacent structures. Pole and cross-arm inspection, including compaction of pole roots and repair of defective poles. Insulator cleaning to remove dirt and prevent electrical or optical interference. Vegetation and Environmental Management Prune branches and clear vegetation near the lines to prevent physical damage and reduce the risk of outages.
