

How to make construction cable tray supports

Mounting Supports: Install support brackets or hangers securely to the structure, ensuring they are level and aligned. Suspended supports should be anchored with appropriate fasteners and vibration-resistant hardware if required.

Tray Placement: Position the cable trays on the supports, ensuring proper alignment and spacing. Connect trays using approved fittings, such as bends, T-pieces, or reducers, to maintain continuous routing.
