To match optical modules correctly, ensure they have the same wavelength, speed, fiber type, and compatible switch connections. Key Factors for Matching Optical Modules

3. Fiber Type Ensure the modules are compatible with the fiber type in use—single-mode (SMF) or multi-mode (MMF). Using a single-mode module on multi-mode fiber or vice versa can result in signal degradation or failure.
4. Switch and Port Compatibility Verify that the optical module is supported by the switch or router. Some modules may be OEM-specific, and unsupported modules can cause ports to remain down or generate error messages. Always check the device documentation for supported transceivers.

Additional Considerations

Optical Power and Distance: Ensure the module's output power and receiver sensitivity match the link distance requirements. Overly long distances or insufficient power can cause errors.

Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM): Modules with DDM allow real-time monitoring of parameters like transmitted power, received power, and temperature, which helps maintain link reliability.
