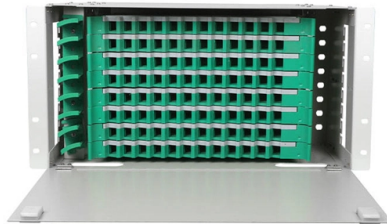


How to network fiber optic cables
