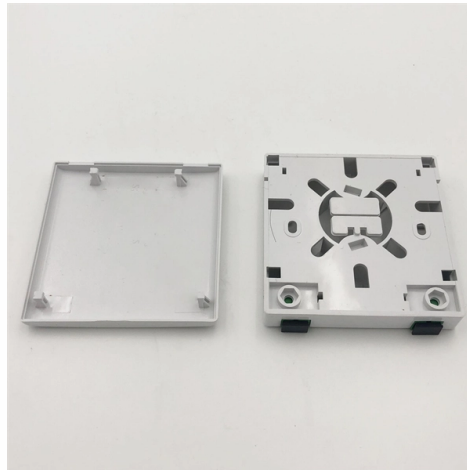

Use Ethernet cables to connect the switch to your computers, servers, or routers. This method is suitable for larger networks or when you want to integrate fiber directly into your LAN infrastructure. Using an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) For fiber internet connections, an ONT converts the incoming fiber signal into Ethernet for your router or devices: Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT. Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router's WAN port. Power on the ONT and router, then verify connectivity.
