

How to retrieve the fiber optic cable

- Store in a clean, dry environment to prevent dust or oil contamination.

Notes for Conduit or Longer Runs

- If extracting fiber from conduit or structured cabling: Use the strength member (Kevlar or aramid yarn) inside the cable jacket to pull the cable, not the outer jacket.
- Ensure the pathway is clear and lubricated if necessary to prevent snagging.
- Follow manufacturer specifications for maximum pull tension to avoid fiber breakage.
