

How to set up an An fiber optic router

Setting up a fiber optic router involves connecting the ONT to your router, configuring network settings, securing Wi-Fi, and optimizing performance for high-speed internet.

Step 1: Verify Fiber Internet Availability Before setup, ensure fiber service is available at your location. Check for existing fiber infrastructure, such as underground cables or utility poles, and confirm eligibility with your ISP.

Step 2: Gather Required Equipment You will need: Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, Fiber optic cable (usually SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors), Compatible router with a WAN or SFP port, Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to the router, Power adapters for both ONT and router.

Step 3: Install the ONT Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (typically 2–5 minutes).

Step 4: Connect the Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port. Plug in and power on the router. Confirm that indicator lights show an active internet connection.

Step 5: Access Router Settings Open a web browser on a device connected to the router. Enter the router's default IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) in the address bar. Log in using the default credentials (often "admin" for both username and password) or as specified by the manufacturer.

Step 6: Configure Internet Connection Navigate to the WAN or network settings. Select the connection type provided by your ISP: PPPoE: Requires username and password; Dynamic/Automatic IP: No credentials needed; Static IP: Use ISP-provided IP, subnet mask, and gateway. Input the necessary credentials and save the settings.

Step 7: Set Up Wi-Fi Assign a unique network name (SSID) for 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz bands. Set a strong Wi-Fi password to secure your network. Enable Wi-Fi 6/AX mode if supported for faster speeds, but disable if older devices experience issues.
