

How to splice drop fiber optic cables in 22s

Splicing 22-fiber drop cables involves careful preparation, precise stripping and cleaving, and fusion splicing each fiber to ensure low-loss, durable connections.

Preparation and Safety Before starting, ensure you have the proper tools and safety equipment: fiber strippers, cleaver, fusion splicer, splice sleeves, alcohol wipes, and safety goggles. Fusion splicing uses an electric arc that can reach over 5,000°C, so wear protective eyewear and cut-resistant gloves and handle fiber shards carefully to avoid injury or contamination. Fiber Preparation Strip the outer jacket of the drop cable using a cable splitter, exposing the buffer tubes. For tight-buffered fibers, carefully strip the 250µm coating without bending the fiber excessively; maintain a bending radius >30 mm. Clean the exposed fiber with an IPA-soaked swab to remove debris and oils. Avoid touching the glass surface.

Cleaving: Use a precision cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end-face. Avoid angled cuts, burrs, or cracks, as these can increase splice loss.

Fusion Splicing Align fibers in the fusion splicer according to the manufacturer's instructions. For a 22-fiber drop, repeat the process for each fiber individually or in ribbon form if using a multi-fiber splicer.

Perform the fusion: The splicer melts the fiber ends together using an electric arc, creating a continuous optical path with minimal reflection and attenuation. Typical splice loss is 0.02–0.05 dB per fiber.

Protect the splice: Slide a splice sleeve over the joint and heat-shrink it to provide mechanical protection and environmental sealing.

Coiling and Documentation After splicing, coil the fibers neatly in the splice tray to prevent stress or bending. Label each fiber according to your network plan to maintain organization and facilitate troubleshooting.
