

How to strip fiber optic cables

Clean the Fiber: After stripping, clean the exposed fiber with a lint-free wipe and alcohol to remove any residue or debris.

Inspect and Cleave: Use a fiber optic cleaver to create a clean, perpendicular end face. Inspect with a microscope or visual fault locator to ensure the fiber is free of nicks or scratches.
