- Fault Detection:** Identifying breaks, bends, or damaged fibers within the box.

Common Testing Methods

- Visible Light Source Testing** Uses a visual fault locator (VFL) to send visible light through the fiber. Helps quickly identify breaks, bends, or misaligned connections. Ideal for initial continuity checks but does not quantify signal loss.
- Power Meter and Light Source (One-Jumper Method)** Measures signal attenuation across the fiber link.

Steps: Disconnect active equipment and calibrate the power meter and light source. Connect the light source to one end of the fiber and measure the received power at the other end. Compare measured loss against TIA/EIA standards for cable, connector, and splice allowances. Provides accurate insertion loss data for certification.- Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR)** Sends pulses of light through the fiber and analyzes reflections. Detects splices, connector losses, bends,...
