

How to use a Huawei 100Mbps optical module

Verifying Operation

Check Interface Status: On a Huawei switch, run `display interface` to view the module type, link status, and traffic statistics. The link must show UP for normal operation.

Interface Overview: Use `display interface brief` to list all interfaces and confirm the correct port number for the module.

Troubleshooting: If the link is down, check fiber connections, module pairing, and ensure the correct fiber type is used. For advanced troubleshooting, you can monitor optical power levels on compatible routers to ensure TX/RX signals are within the optimal range.

Best Practices

Keep dust plugs on unused modules to prevent contamination. Avoid bending fiber cables sharply to prevent signal loss. Reserve link budget margins when using splitters or long-distance fiber runs. Regularly monitor module status to detect early signs of degradation or faults. By following these steps, a Huawei 100Mbps optical module can be properly installed, paired, and monitored...
