Mount the cable management racks near patch panels and switches to guide cables neatly and reduce strain. Route cables through management racks to maintain separation between power and data lines, improve airflow, and prevent tangling. Use cable ties or Velcro straps to secure bundles without over-tightening, which can damage cables.
