All 120-volt receptacles in or near the cabinet must have GFCI protection, either via a GFCI breaker or an upstream GFCI outlet. Follow local building codes for outlet spacing, height, and clearance, especially near sinks or wet areas. Ensure proper grounding for all circuits and appliances.

Testing and Safety

After wiring, test each circuit individually for continuity and proper voltage. Verify that GFCI outlets trip correctly. Ensure all connec...
