

How to wire copper strips to a distribution box

Maintain uniform spacing and avoid sharp bends (). Ensure wiring direction: incoming main lines typically enter from the left, and outgoing branch circuits exit on the right (). Label each wire or circuit clearly to simplify future maintenance and inspections (). **Final Checks** Perform a visual inspection to confirm all connections are tight, wires are properly seated, and there...
