Huawei switches can operate without optical modules by using copper ports, but optical modules are required for fiber connections and certified modules ensure reliability. Operation Without Optical Modules Huawei switches are designed with both copper (Ethernet) and optical (SFP/SFP+/QSFP) ports. If your network only requires copper connections, you can operate the switch without installing optical modules. Copper ports use standard Ethernet cables (Cat5e, Cat6, or higher) to connect devices, providing reliable data transmission for most campus or enterprise networks. Optical modules are only necessary when connecting over fiber links for longer distances or higher-speed connections. Risks of Using Non-Certified Optical Modules Huawei strictly recommends using Huawei-certified optical modules for fiber connections. Non-certified modules may cause: Installation failures due to non-standard sizes or structures. Data bus suspension or errors on the switch. Damage to optical interfaces from improper edge connectors. Incorrect temperature monitoring and service interruptions. Electromagnetic interference and reduced anti-interference capability. These risks do not apply if you are using copper ports only, so operating without optical modules avoids these issues entirely. Certification and Compatibility Huawei started certifying optical modules for S switches in 2013 for 10GE and lower speeds and in 2016 for 25GE, 40GE, and 100GE modules. Certified modules are labeled with "HUAWEI" and verified for interoperability, ensuring stable performance. Using non-certified modules triggers alarms in newer switch firmware (V200R001 and later), but these alarms do not affect copper port operation. Practical Recommendations If your network does not require fiber, use copper ports exclusively and no optical modules are needed. For fiber connections, always use Huawei-certified optical modules to ensure reliability and avoid service issues. If non-certified modules are used, be aware of potential alarms and operational risks, and consult Huawei te...
