Compliance: Adhere to local electrical codes (e.g., NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components (UL, CE) to ensure safety and legal compliance. Record installation details for future inspections.

Maintenance: Schedule regular inspections to check for loose connections, dust accumulation, or signs of overheating. Label all circuits clearly to facilitate troubleshooting and upgrades.
