For vertical or horizontal managers, ensure the D-rings, bend radius fingers, or brush strips are properly oriented for cable routing. Installing the Bracket Hold one side of the assembled bracket against the rack flange at the rear of the rack. Insert screws through the rack flange into the bracket, typically three screws per side, using the middle holes of the EIA units. Repeat for the opposite side to secure the bracket firmly. For brackets mounted on equipment faceplates (like MIO/UMIO cards), secure cables with cable ties or hook-and-loop straps. Routing and Securing Cables Feed network or power cables through the bracket or tray. Use cable ties, hook-and-loop straps, or removable D-rings to organize cables neatly. Ensure cables are not bent beyond their minimum bend radius to prevent damage.
