

Installation Requirements for Cable Trays and Brackets

Step 3: Install Brackets

- Wall Mounting (Cantilever Brackets):** Drill holes at marked points, insert wall anchors (expansion bolts for concrete), and secure the cantilever brackets ensuring they are level.
- Ceiling Suspension (Trapeze or C-Hanger):** Drill holes into the ceiling slab, install drop-in anchors, screw in threaded rods, and attach a Unistrut channel horizontally to create a shelf for the tray. Level the strut using nuts and washers.
- End Brackets:** For tray ends, attach end brackets to the wall or floor using the included screw set.

Step 4: Prepare and Place Trays

- Measure and Cut:** Cut tray sections to fit specific lengths or corners using a hacksaw or angle grinder.
- Deburr:** Remove sharp edges with a file to prevent cable...
