For older or disabled users, slightly lower heights around 1.2–1.4 meters may be considered for convenience.

Outdoor Installation Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above the ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts. For stainless steel or IP67-rated enclosures, the bottom surface is often set between 1.3 and 1.5 meters to facilitate comfortable operation and routine maintenance. Mobile or irrigation controller enclosures may be installed lower, between 0.6 and 1.5 meters, depending on accessibility needs.

Ground-Mounted Boxes Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated, typically 2–4 inches above the ground, to prevent moisture damage and ensure durability. Consistency in height across multiple boxes in the same area is important for aesthetics and systematic management, with allowable deviations usually within 10 millimeters.

Electrical Boxes and Switch Boxes Electrical switch boxes and terminal boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible locations, with the horizontal distance between a switch box and the controlled equipment not exceeding 3 meters to reduce line losses and improve efficiency. Adequate space around the box should allow at least two people to work simultaneously for mainten...
