

Installation height of household electrical distribution box

Considerations Maintain a minimum front workspace of 3 feet and a width of at least 30 inches for safe operation and maintenance. Avoid installing panels in wet areas, bathrooms, closets, or behind furniture to prevent hazards and ensure compliance with NEC requirements. Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet above ground to protect against water and dirt, and ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2-4 inches to avoid moisture damage.
