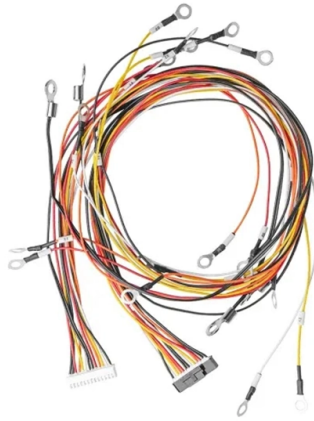


Installation method of 288 junction box



AI Overview

The 288 junction box should be installed by securely mounting it, connecting wires according to function, grounding properly, and ensuring all connections are protected and accessible.

Step 1: Safety First Before starting, turn off the power at the circuit breaker to prevent electric shock. Test the wires with a voltage tester to ensure they are not energized. Only use parts provided with the junction box and avoid substituting or using damaged components, as this can void safety certifications and create hazards.

Step 2: Prepare the Mounting Location Choose a location that is accessible for future inspection or maintenance. For ceiling or wall installations, ensure the box is aligned with the finished surface. Use the correct mounting method for the box type (metal or plastic) and secure it to framing or a stable structure.

Step 3: Cable Entry and Conductor Preparation Route cables or conduits into the box through the designated entry points. Use cable clamps or strain relief connectors to protect insulation and secure the wires mechanically. Strip insulation carefully, leaving enough conductor length inside the box for safe splicing and future servicing.

Step 4: Grounding If the box is metal, connect the ground wire to the box using the provided grounding screw. Ensure all equipment grounding conductors are joined properly before connecting other conductors.

Step 5: Wire Connections Connect conductors by function: hot to hot, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground. Use approved wire nuts or terminal blocks to secure splices. For multiple wires, create pigtails if necessary to maintain secure connections.

Step 6: Final Assembly Carefully fold wires into the box, ensuring there is enough space for movement without overstuffing. Close the box with the provided cover, keeping it accessible for future maintenance. Verify that all connections are tight and that the box is stable.

Step 7: Testing Once installed, restore power and test the circuit to ensure proper operation. Check that all connections are secure and that there are no exposed wires.
