

Installation of Roller-Type Cable Trays

3. Position the Roller Ensure the roller aligns with the cable pull direction. For speed mount rollers, the pull should go from the clamp side toward the front side of the roller. For other types, make sure the roller sits firmly on the supporting member.
4. Secure the Roller Tighten bolts or wing nuts to hold the roller in place. Insert locking underpins or clamps in the designated openings to prevent movement during cable pulling.
5. Test and Adjust After installation, check that the roller spins freely and is stable. Adjust the position if necessary to ensure smooth cable movement and prevent kinks or damage during installation.
6. Lay Cables Using Rollers Once rollers are installed, cables can be pulled along the tray efficiently. Use multiple rollers for long runs or heavy cables to reduce friction and strain on the cables.
7. Maintenance Tips Regularly inspect rollers for wear, loose bolts, or misalignment. Replace damaged rollers promptly to maintain safe and efficient cable handling.
