Mounting and Support Secure the trays using mounting brackets, wall arms, or ceiling struts attached to the iron tower. Standard support spacing is typically 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. For heavy-duty installations, shorter spacing (1.5 m) ensures rigidity, while longer spacing (3 m) reduces material costs but requires stronger trays. Ensure all supports are level and aligned to prevent sagging, which can damage cables. Load Considerations Calculate the total cable weight per meter to select the correct tray thickness and support brackets. Avoid exceeding the maximum load capacity of the tray or hangers, which can range from 318 kg to 340 kg per hanger depending on the system. Installation Steps Inspect the area: Clear obstructions like pipes or HVAC ducts. Install supports: Attach brackets or hangers at marked points. Assemble trays: Connect sections using couplers or splice plates, ensuring alignment. Lay cables: Place cables carefully, maintaining separation and fill ratios (typically max 50% of tray capacity).
