Switches must operate flexibly and reliably, with clear labeling for identification.
4. Environmental and Installation Factors Ensure adequate ventilation and heat dissipation to avoid overheating. Install boxes at accessible heights (typically ~1.5 m) and in dry, ventilated areas. Use IP/NEMA-rated enclosures suitable for indoor or outdoor conditions.
5. Practical Quota Determination While there is no universal numeric quota, the practical limit is determined by:
 - The number of available DIN rail slots or busbar positions.
 - The rated current and thermal capacity of the busbar.
