3. Environmental Awareness Modern iPDUs often include temperature and humidity sensors to monitor environmental conditions within racks. This supports improved reliability, especially in non-conditioned environments, and helps prevent overheating or equipment failure.
4. Scalability and Redundancy Design should consider modular and daisy-chaining capabilities, allowing multiple PDUs to be connected while reducing IP address requirements. Coordinated deployment ensures scalability for growing infrastructure and redundancy to maintain uptime in case of PDU or power source failure.
5. Surge Protection and Safety Integrated surge protection safeguards sensitive IT equipment from transient electrical disturbances. Proper grounding, circuit protection, and adherence to electrical standards are essential for safe and reliable operation.
