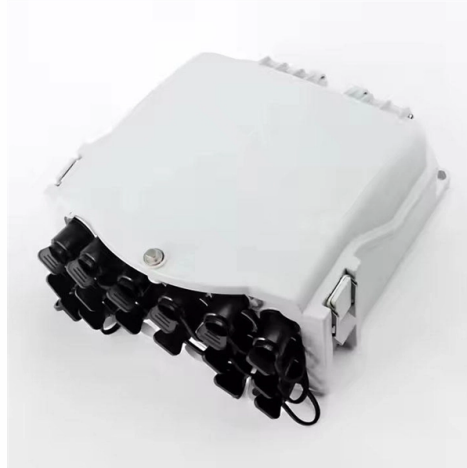


Is HDMI an FC interface

FC interfaces are optimized for data storage and networking, not for audiovisual transmission. In contrast, HDMI is specifically for audio/video signal transmission and does not support the protocols, speeds, or features of Fibre Channel . Key Features of HDMI Supports high-definition video up to 8K resolution and high refresh rates . Transmits digital audio alongside video in a single cable . Includes features like HDMI Ethernet Channel (HEC), Audio Return Channel (ARC/eARC), and Consumer Electronics Control (CEC) . Electrically compatible with DVI signals, allowing adapters without signal loss . Conclusion HDMI is a digital multimedia interface for audiovisual applications and is not related to Fibre Channel. It cannot be used for FC networking or storage purposes, as its design, protocol, and use cases are entirely different from those of FC interfaces .
