PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt, Type 3 and 4): Delivers up to 60–100 watts per port, ideal for high-power devices like multi-radio access points, building automation systems, and small computers . PoE switches can also be managed or unmanaged, with managed switches offering advanced network control, monitoring, and segmentation features...
