They focus on cable management and accessibility rather than heavy load support or advanced cooling. Network racks may have modular designs and simpler ventilation since network devices generate less heat and are lighter than servers.

- Depth:** Server racks are deeper to fit larger equipment; network racks are shallower.
- Cooling and Weight:** Server racks are built for heavy loads and heat-intensive devices; network racks are lighter and require less cooling.
- Equipment:** Server racks accommodate rack servers, storage, and PDUs; network racks accommodate switches, routers, and patch panels.
