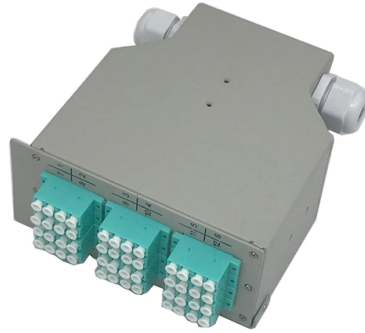


Is it safe to pull fiber optic cable coils

Avoid Looking Directly Into the Fiber End Face Never stare into the open end of a fiber cable. The light that comes out is invisible yet intense. Most fiber damage does not come from normal operation after the system is live. It happens during installation, when excessive pulling force, tight bends. CAUTION: Care must be taken to avoid cable damage during handling and placing. Most fiber optic cables boast a pull strength of 100 – 200.
