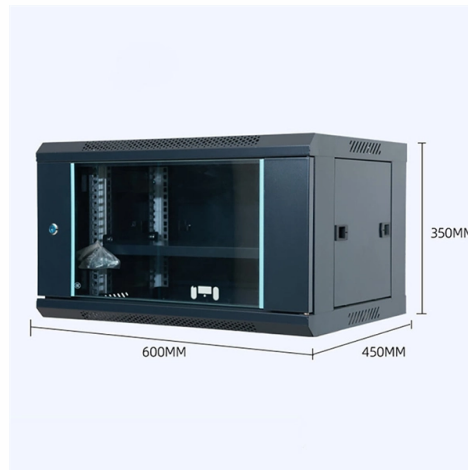

MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On) connectors are high-density fiber optic connectors designed to carry multiple fibers—typically 12 or more—within a single interface. SN®-MT They support both single-mode (SM) and multimode (MM) fibers and are widely used in space-constrained environments requiring high. If you only remember one thing: MPO is a multi-fiber connector standardized under IEC 61754-7 that allows you to terminate 8, 12, 16, 24, or even 32 fibers in a single rectangular ferrule. Instead of plugging 12 separate LC duplex connectors, you can mate one MPO. Where it's used: Data center.
