

Laying Fiber Optic Cable Reel

Controlled Pulling: Pull the cable slowly and steadily, avoiding sharp bends or exceeding the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer.

Managing Cable Squirting: If the cable begins to squirt from the feed hole, do not attempt to stop it forcibly. Stop deployment, cut the excess tail, and re-spool or reposition the cable in a figure-8 configuration.

Tension Monitoring: Ensure the residual tension on the cable does not exceed the maximum recommended load, especially for vertical installations where clamping intervals are critical.

Post-Deployment Inspect the laid cable for any kinks, twists, or damage. Re-secure any protective sheathing if removed during installation. For long-term installations, clamp the cable at recommended intervals to prevent sagging or movement. By following these steps, fiber optic cab...

All Fiber Optic Cable reels should be stored upright Laying the reel on its side may cause damage to the reel flange and/or cause the cable layers to shift – This may cause cable to snag during de-reeling.

Inspect the cable reel for signs of excessive weathering and/or damage. Reels must be transported or stored with their battens intact. Do not accept delivery of an fiber optic cable reel

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When a reel of fiber cable is shipped from the manufacturer, it is structurally sound and will protect the fiber cable during transporting and the payout installation.
