Installation and Placement

- Height:** Typically installed 1.5 meters above the ground for accessibility and safety.
- Location:** Positioned near concentrated electrical loads, but within 30 meters of the main distribution box to minimize voltage drop.
- Environment:** Must be installed in ventilated, dry areas away from harmful gases, liquids, heat sources, or areas prone to impact or vibration.
- Accessibility:** Sufficient space should be provided for two people to operate and maintain the box safely, with no obstructions like stacked materials or vegetation.

Safety Features Level 2 boxes incorporate two-level protection, meaning they include leakage protection switches both at the secondary box and at the main distribution box. This ensures that any electrical fault or leakage is detected and isolated, reducing the risk of electric shock. The principle of “one machine, one gate, one leak, one box, one lock” is applied, meaning each switch controls only one piece of equipment or socket to prevent overloading.

Construction and Standards

- Material:** Made from iron plate or high-quality insulating materials, with metal thickness typically greater than 1.5 mm.
- Protection Class:** Should have at least IP55 rating, providing protection against dust and water jets, suitable for harsh cons...
