

Minimum cable tray hanger specifications



AI Overview

Cable tray hangers must meet minimum material, thickness, and dimensional standards, typically using stainless steel channels of at least 2.5mm thickness with proper load safety factors. Material Requirements Cable tray hangers and mounting channels should be made of stainless steel complying with BS EN 10088-2 Grade 1.4401 (ASTM 316) to ensure corrosion resistance and structural integrity in various environments. All associated fasteners, including bolts, nuts, washers, and anchor bolts, must also meet the same stainless steel grade. Minimum Dimensions and Thickness Mounting Channels: Minimum thickness of 2.5mm, nominal dimensions 40mm x 40mm, with a nominal distance of 20mm between lips. Cantilever Arms: Minimum thickness of 2.5mm, designed to secure to channel sections with a single nut and bolt, including a locating tongue for stability. Channel Angle Support Brackets: Must accommodate M12 bolts and be compatible with the mounting channels. Load and Safety Considerations Mounting channels should be designed with an axial loading safety factor of 2.5 to ensure structural reliability under cable loads. Anchor bolts and sleeves must be designed and approved for the expected load before installation. Hanger spacing and support placement should follow manufacturer recommendations and applicable standards such as NEMA VE 1 and ANSI/NFPA 70. Installation Notes Cable trays should be supported using the specified channels, cantilever arms, and brackets, ensuring proper alignment and secure fastening. Field verification of dimensions and routing is required to accommodate actual site conditions. All components, including clamps, splice plates, and expansion joints, should be included in submittal drawings and product data for approval. Summary For safe and compliant cable tray installation, use stainless steel hangers and channels of at least 2.5mm thickness, with proper dimensions, M12 fasteners, and a safety factor of 2.5, following NEMA and NEC standards.
