Inside the cable, individual fibers are color-coded according to the TIA-598 standard, which ensures consistent identification across installations. Key points include:

- 12-Color Sequence:** Standard colors are Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. For cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with stripe markers to distinguish higher-numbered fibers.
- High-Count Cables:** In cables with multiple tubes (e.g., 48, 96, 144 fibers), the "Tube and Fiber" system is used. Each tube has a color, and fibers inside follow the 12-color sequence, allowing precise identification of any fiber in the bundle.
