Mechanical Risks Fiber cables are highly sensitive to bending, stretching, or crushing. Exceeding the minimum bend radius or tensile strength can crack the glass core, leading to signal loss or complete failure. Mobile deployments, where cables are frequently moved or routed through tight spaces, increase the risk of kinking, bending, or accidental impact, which can disrupt service and require costly repairs.

Chemical Exposure During installation and maintenance, technicians may use cleaning agents, epoxies, or curing chemicals. Prolonged or repeated exposure to these substances without proper ventilation can cause respiratory issues, skin irritation, or other health complications. Awareness of chemical hazards and adherence to safety protocols is critical.
