- Accidental impact:** Construction work, vehicle contact, or improper handling during installation can sever or nick the cable. Even minor damage, such as a small nick, can significantly reduce transmission distance and bandwidth, potentially affecting an entire neighborhood's connectivity.

- Inspect the cable:** Check for visible cuts, bends, or connector issues.
- Test the link:** Use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) or OLTS (Optical Loss Test Set) to locate breaks or measure signal loss.
- Repair or replace:** Damaged sections may require splicing or full cable replacement. Ensure proper bend radius and secure fixation during reinstallation.
- Prevent future damage:** Use armored or rodent-resistant cables in high-risk areas, maintain clear routing paths, and follow p...
