Optical ports on Moxa managed switches can be configured via web, Telnet, or console interfaces to set speed, duplex, auto-negotiation, and VLAN parameters. Accessing the Switch You can configure optical ports on a Moxa switch using three main methods: Web Interface: Connect your PC to the switch on the same subnet, open a browser, and log in using the switch's IP address (default is usually 192.168.127.253) to access the management console. Telnet Console: Ensure your PC is on the same subnet, then connect via Telnet to the switch's IP address. This allows command-line configuration of optical ports. Serial Console (RS-232): Use an RJ45-to-DB9 cable to connect the switch's console port to your PC. Open a terminal emulator (VT100 recommended) to access configuration commands. Configuring Optical Port Parameters Once connected, you can configure the following key optical port settings: Speed and Duplex: Set the port to 1000 Mbps full-duplex or auto-negotiation depending on the connected device and fiber type. Auto-Negotiation: Enable or disable auto-negotiation to match the capabilities of the connected fiber device. VLAN Assignment: Assign the optical port to a specific VLAN for network segmentation. Link Aggregation: Combine multiple optical ports for higher bandwidth or redundancy if supported. Port Status Monitoring: Check link status, errors, and traffic statistics to ensure proper operation. These settings are typically found under the Port Configuration or Interface Settings section in the web interface, or via equivalent commands in Telnet/console mode. Best Practices Match Fiber Type: Ensure the optical transceiver type (SFP, SFP+, etc.) matches the fiber cable and distance requirements. Check Duplex and Speed: Mismatched duplex or speed can cause packet loss or collisions. Enable Monitoring: Use port statistics and alarms to detect link degradation early. Document VLANs: Keep a record of VLAN assignments to avoid misconfigurations in industrial networks. By following these steps, you can...
