Some pre-terminated cables are labeled to simplify this. Plug in the Cable - Insert the LC connectors into the SFP module ports. Ensure a secure fit without forcing the connectors. Verify Link Status - Check the switch LEDs or interface status to confirm the link is active. If the link does not come up, verify the fiber type, SFP compatibility, and TX/RX orientation . Troubleshooting Tips Fiber Type Mismatch - Using OM4 fiber with an older SFP module may prevent the link from coming up; switching to OM3 can resolve this . Distance Limitations - Multimode SFP modules have maximum reach (e.g., 400 meters for 10G-SR). Ensure the cable length does not exceed specifications . Clean Connectors - Dirty or damaged connectors can cause...
