- Depth:** Determines how far equipment extends into the cabinet, important for larger servers or UPS systems ().

Cabinets are also categorized by mounting type:

- Floor-standing cabinets:** Suitable for data centers or server rooms, supporting heavy equipment and high-density setups ().
- Wall-mounted cabinets:** Ideal for small offices or network closets, conserving floor space while providing secure housing ().

Classification by Functionality

Network cabinets can be further classified based on their features:

- Standard cabinets:** Basic enclosures for organizing and securing equipment.
- Cooling-optimized cabinets:** Include perforated doors, ventilation panels, or integrated fans to manage heat from high-performance devices ().
- High-performance cabinets:** Designed for heavy loads, with reinforced rails, static and dynamic load capacity, and modular designs for scalability ().
- Security-focused cabinets:** Equipped with locks and restricted access to prevent unauthorized tampering ().
