Common heights range from 24U to 48U, with 42U being standard for data centers. The frame may include grounding points, anti-tip mechanisms, and reinforced bases to ensure stability and safety.

Mounting Rails: Vertical rails inside the rack, pre-drilled with standardized holes, allow secure attachment of servers, switches, and other devices. Rails can be threaded or tool-less, and rear mounting posts provide flexibility for deeper equipment, distributing weight evenly.

Brackets and Shelves: Non-rack-mountable devices or lighter equipment are supported using brackets or cantilever shelves. Heavier devices may require four-point shelves for stability. These components ensure that all equipment, regardless of form factor, can be securely installed.
