- Horizontal types:** Mounted between equipment, often with finger ducts, D-rings, or brush strips, ideal for managing cables front-to-back.
- Vertical types:** Mounted on rack sides, allowing flexible left-right and front-back routing, suitable for large-scale cabling.

Cable managers prevent tension on patch panel modules, reducing the risk of poor connections or network failures.

- Plan Rack Layout:** Position patch panels at the front for easy access and cable managers at the top, sides, or between equipment to optimize routing space.
- Install Patch Panels:** Secure panels in the rack, ensuring ports are accessible for connecting devices and future upgrades.
- Install Cable Managers:** Choose appropriate horizontal or vertical managers and secure them to guide cables without sharp bends.
